

# CODE OF CONDUCT

Brownsburg Hoops wants each individual to recognize that sportsmanship is a critical component in the development of our athletes.

We have established a few guidelines which we want to inform the parents/guardians on. During practices for all grades, there will be no individuals except the head coach, assistant coaches and Brownsburg Hoops representatives in the gymnasium at Eagle Elementary. If any individuals want to stay at the Eagle Elementary, they are allowed to wait in the lobby.

At the basketball games, all individuals must refrain from criticizing the referees, coaches, other individuals in the stands and athletes. We want to have a positive environment for our boys to learn in. If anyone notes areas of concern with our Brownsburg individuals, please contact the Director of Brownsburg Hoops.

Coaches will also be put to a higher standard in the Brownsburg Hoops program. The coaches are responsible for the actions of their players and fans. If a technical foul is called against his/her team, the head coach must notify the Director of Brownsburg Hoops of the incident that night.

The Director of Brownsburg Hoops will handle each issue on a case by case basis which would be at the least - a warning, and the maximum – removal of the athlete from Brownsburg Hoops or removal of the coach/assistant coach from Brownsburg Hoops program. We do not expect there to be any warnings needed for any teams.
